Terms of Agreement



General & payment info:

- First day of all programs is September 11, 2023. Last day of all programs is June 16, 2024. Please refer to our calendar for all closing dates.
- Our First Semester dates are September 11, 2023 January 28, 2024
- Our Second Semester dates are January 29, 2024 June 16, 2024
- There are NO make ups. If your child is absent due to any reason (sick, vacation, etc.) refund for the missing day(s) cannot be issued.
- For the full year programs, the deposit of \$500 should be made to secure your spot. The tuition can be paid in full by September 11, 2023 or split into multiple payments (payment plan). If you decide to stop the program at any time, your \$500 deposit can't be refunded.
- For the semester programs, the tuition should be made by September 1st, 2023 for the First semester classes and by January 15, 2024 for the Second semester classes. If you decide to stop the program at any time, your semester tuition can't be refunded.

Arrival, dismissal, early pick up & absence:

- Children must be checked in with the Zplay staff upon arrival to any and all programs.
- Children must be picked up after the class is finished by an authorized person only.
- If your child will not be attending due to vacation, illness, or other plans, please notify us.

Clothing & Food:

- Children should wear comfortable clothing to move around and parents should be comfortable in them getting these clothes dirty during some crafts activities.
- Children will drink water out of their own labeled water bottles (Zplay staff will refill their bottles happily).

Communication:

- Contact between parents and the program director, Marina Zurakhinsky, is an important part of the program. By sharing information about your child, we can work together to better meet the child's needs. If a problem or an area of concerns arises, it should be brought to our attention.
- Parents will receive an access to a photo gallery for their child.

Medical needs & emergencies:

- Parents should make aware the program director of any allergies or medical conditions of the child. Zplay staff is unable to administer any medications to the child. If your child requires medication during program hours, please arrange for their caregiver to bring them the medication and administer it. If your child needs to carry an Epi-Pen or an inhaler, (please label them with child's first and last name), have them bring it with them.
- In the event of an accident, injury, or illness, our staff members will notify a parent and/or a caregiver. Minor injuries (scrapes, small cuts) will be treated by Zplay First Aid trained staff. If medical attention is necessary, the caregiver and parent will be notified immediately to pick up the child and proceed with the proper care.
- A child with a fever (100° or higher) must stay home for 24 hours after the fever has subsided.
- Children with inflamed eyes, especially with discharge, must be kept home until symptoms disappear or a physician states the eye condition is not contagious.
- Communicable diseases and conditions, such as strep throat, conjunctivitis, lice, etc., require the child remain home until they are either symptom-free for 24 hours or have been on a regular course of antibiotics for 48 hours. If the condition arises during school hours, the child must be picked up immediately.
- If your child has a communicable disease, do not send them to the program until they are fever free for 24 hours. The same applies for vomiting or diarrhea.
- If your child develops a contagious illness, either during program or outside of program hours, please email the program director as soon as possible. In some cases, preventative measures may be taken to protect exposed children from onset of the illness. All communicable diseases should be reported.
